Sedum Cuttings

Optigreen Sedum Cuttings contain various sedum species for use on extensive green roofs. (we recommend additional seeding with seed mix to increase the variety of species).



Material	Cuttings (shoots) of various sedum types
Required quantity	50-80 g/m ²
Composition	small-leafed: - Sedum album, various species - Sedum sexangulare - Sedum lydium glaucum large-leafed: - Sedum spurium, various species - Sedum hybridum, "Immergrünchen" - Sedum floriferum, "Weihenstephaner Gold" - Sedum kamtschatikum - Sedum rupestre - Sedum reflexum
Delivery form	in breathable, coarse-mesh plastic sacks
Quantity/delivered unit	according to size of order delivery by parcel service or forwarding agent.
Storage	Unpack unused cuttings and spread them out thinly on a dry surface. Sprouts will last for 1 to 2 days if kept cool and dry.

Area of use

- On extensive green roofs

Specific properties

- Quality of the cuttings as per the classification of perennials
- Number of flowering cuttings less than 5% of the total volume

Note

The composition and percentage distribution of the varieties are subject to seasonal fluctuations based on the harvest time. Expected variety composition according to harvesting time:

- From approx. beginning of May to end of September at least five small- and large-leaf varieties with at least 40% proportion of large-leaf varieties
- In the transitional period October/November or middle/end of March to end of April approx. 10-20% large-leaf varieties
- From December to approx. middle/end of March, the mixture can be reduced to approx. 95% small-leaf varieties such as e.g. Sedum album and Sedum hispanicum and to approx. 5% large-leaf varieties

Important information

In the winter months, it is often not possible to produce/deliver cuttings due to the weather.
